- Award-making has been unstructured up until now however as we move forward, Gayle
 and Sam identified need for policy moving forward around number of years that an
 organization may request/receive a subsidy. There was also conversation around
 assumptions about who needs the subsidies large v. small organizations. Sam and
 Damon will draft proposal and share with Membership Committee (Janelle and Alicia).
- \$6,000 was granted and we have used \$800 to date. Since award was made half-way through AHS's fiscal year, we anticipate dispersing more subsidies during current annual renewal process.

- There was some discussion about areas for improvement for the event.
