# All Townships offer these services to Lake County residents:

#### **Energy & Gas Assistance:**

#### • LIHEAP

- About: LIHEAP is a federal/state program. Those eligible may receive a yearly credit on their gas and electricity bills. This program is intended for IL residents with a household income not exceeding an amount determined annually by the Department of Commerce. LIHEAP offers assistance to pay for home services and heating during the winter months.
- O How to Apply: Applications are accepted by appointment only. Applicants must bring proof of income for the last 30 days, original documents (current electricity and gas bills in the applicant/Head of Household's name), wages, Social Security, SSI, unemployment, child support, and any other source of income. Applicants should also bring a rental lease or Lake County Housing Agreement and a Social Security card for each member of the household.

#### • NICOR Sharing Program (Nicor Gas)

- One-time annual grants are given, with no requirement to be paid back, to qualified residential customers who meet the required income guidelines. The Nicor Gas Sharing Program is administered by the Salvation Army and funded through direct contributions from Nicor Gas' customers and employees.
- Share the Warmth (Peoples Gas)
  - The North Shore Gas Program is administered by the Community Action Partnership of Lake County (CAP). It is available to qualified low-income residents.
- ComEd Hardships

#### **General & Emergency Assistance:**

#### General Assistance

Program assists with monthly basic living expenses. It provides residents assistance in the form of \$400 that can be used towards rent, utilities, and food expenses. To be eligible, one must be unemployed and actively seeking employment; or they must be awaiting a decision on a social security disability claim. Applicants also have to meet state-mandated qualifications.

#### • Emergency Assistance

- Program assists with alleviating a life-threatening circumstance or job-related expense, loss of income, reduction in employment hours, medical illness, and/or other emergency hardships.
- Lake County Prescription Discount Card
- SHIP Senior Services
- Assistance enrolling for health insurance on Federal Marketplace
  - Under the Affordable Care Act (ACA), there are trained and certified counselors who can confidentially meet and assist residents one-on-one to explore their health insurance options, balance medical needs and budgets, compare coverage and costs, and ensure that enrollees obtain premium subsidies and cost-sharing reductions based on income.
- Free income tax return preparations for low- and- moderate income taxpayers
  - Program is offered through IRS Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA). Volunteers are trained and certified by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) to prepare basic returns for taxpayers earning less than \$60,000 per year. To apply, one must bring a photo ID for both taxpayer and spouse & Social Security card(s) or ITIN letter(s) for each member of the household. Taxpayers do not need to be Township residents to use this service
- Free Notary Services
- Application Assistance:
  - Department of Human Services (DHS): Medicaid / Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) / Temporary Assistance for Needy families (TANF)
  - o Illinois Department of Aging Benefit Access Program
  - Resource referral for specific needs

#### Transportation Assistance

- Pace Dial-A-Ride
  - For Seniors (age 60+) and People With Disabilities (age 16+) who reside in Shields Township. Shield Township registration required. A registered person may call Pace 24 hours in advance to reserve a curb-to-curb ride to anywhere within Shields and to other locations outside Shields Township. Each fare trip, (one-way) is \$3. Service hours are Monday through Friday from 6 am to 6 pm.
- RTA Reduced-Fore Permits
  - For seniors and individuals with disabilities. Must be 65 years or older and not already enrolled in the Illinois Department on Aging's Benefit Access program. Apply at Shields Township office, and bring

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a driver's license/state ID, as well as a wallet-size photo of yourself (or they can take your picture for \$5 cash or check). To renew your application visit https://fares.rtachicago.org/

- Benefit Access Program (Senior Program)
  - License plate fee discount
  - Free rides on fixed-route transit systems
  - Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP), for those who are thinking of retiring and need assistance in deciding Medicare options. Contact Township to set up an appointment to learn about SHIP.
- Social Services for Seniors
  - The Senior Center has a Social Service staff ready to assist residents. Information and assistance can be provided in applying for federal, state and local programs including:
    - License Plate Sticker Discount & RTA Senior Ride Free & Medicare and Social Security Information and Assistance Receiving these two benefits begins with filing ONE application: The Illinois Benefit Access Application. To be eligible one must be 65 or older, or over 16 and totally disabled; AND have a qualifying annual income. Applications must be submitted online. Make an appointment to learn more about the program and what documents are needed.
    - Secretary of State's Office Information and assistance is provided with driver's licenses and registration sticker renewal, State ID and REAL ID
    - Medicare and Social Security Information and Assistance -Trained Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP) counselors are available by appointment to provide information and assistance navigating the Medicare and Social Security process and what you need to know to avoid penalties as well as one-on-one assistance with:
      - Enrollment
      - Advantage Plans
      - Supplements/Medigap
      - Medicare Savings Program
      - Prescription Drug Plans/Part D
      - Insurance Claims
